# LRI MS Connection 2

## Call for Proposals

- > Justice Programme: Call for proposals for action grants to support national or transnational e-Justice projects, ID: JUST-JACC-EJU-AG-2019
- > Same Call as for LRI (2017 JUST-JACC-EJU-AG-2017, Spring 2017)
- > Budget available: € 2.200.000 (↓ down from EUR 3.552.000)
- > Funding rate: 90 % (↑ Up from 80 %)
- > Deadline: 13 June 2019 at 17:00 (possible extension)
- > Duration: 24 months maximum

# LRI MS Connection 2

## Call – Priorities

- > Call priorities:
  - “Land Registers Interconnection”
  - “European e-Justice Strategy and Action Plan for the 2019-2023”
  - “it aims to support the implementation of e-Justice projects within the European e-Justice Portal and at national level, so long as they have a European dimension. Priority will also be given to projects aiming to join or enhance existing or ongoing e-Justice Portal projects”
- > Interest in raising MS participation in e-Justice Calls

# LRI MS Connection 2

## Call - Funded activities

- > Funded activities (2017 and 2019 terms almost identical):
  - analytical, conceptual, design and elaboration work;
  - IT software development,
  - quality assurance including related auxiliary measures necessary for the establishment of new IT systems;
  - expansion and adaptation of existing national and transnational solutions towards addressing the objectives of the call.
  - Activities relating to project management, content preparation, editorial work, communication, promotion and dissemination are also eligible for funding.
- All activities are applicable for LRI 2

# LRI MS Connection 2

## Call - Expected results

- > Expected results (2017 and 2019 terms very similar):
  - Improved participation with the aim of achieving full EU coverage concerning all voluntary e-Justice interconnection projects;
  - Opportunities allowing Member States to engage in new pilot initiatives identified as part of the European e-Justice Action Plan (2019-2023)
  - Improved awareness of on-going and future e-Justice activities.
- All expected results applicable for LRI 2

- > Title: LRI Member State Connection 2 – Connection of additional Member States to the Land Registers Interconnection (LRI) Platform
- > Acronym: LRI MS Connection 2
- > Goal:
  - Connect new MS to the central LRI (knowledge transfer by AT and EE)
  - Consolidation of the project results
- > Grant ID: JUST-JACC-EJU-AG-2019
- > Funding Rate: 90 %
- > Duration: 15 months
- > Proposed start: 1 March 2020
- > Proposed end: 31 May 2021
- > Project Partners: AT, EE, tbd

# LRI MS Connection 2

## Project Proposal - Work Packages

- > WP1: Project management & coordination
  - Reporting, Project Plan, Kick-Off-Meeting, ...
- > WP2: Business analysis and solution design for LRI requests/responses
  - Gap analysis, design of architecture and specifications of national LRI components, ...
- > WP3: Consolidation, Development, Test and Deployment of national components for LRI Requests/Responses
  - Implement the Web service modules, updated test plans, enhancement of existing national LRI components, ...
- > WP4: Publicity and dissemination of deliverables
  - Raising awareness: Updated website, promotional materials, ...
