BORIS status

Target go-live date for Phase 1 is 31 October 2021
Scope: the application itself and the web XSD interfaces for VAT calculation and payment (but not payment implementation).

It will make available free documents from 7 Member States
Payments to be added in Q2 2022.

Authorization to be added in 2022 depending on the implementation progress of Member States, starting with a pilot project.



Distributed payment solution

The proposed solution is an HTTPS redirection through a web page on the Member State Land Register. LRI will send to the register the total VAT-inclusive price in local currency, together with the label to display already translated in the user's language ("Proceed to payment for the amount of 12€ VAT inclusive"). This landing page will also have one button to proceed to the PSP and automatic return to LRI after the payment is done, and one button to cancel and return to LRI. LRI will also send as a parameter the user's language for the case that the MS PSP is multilingual.

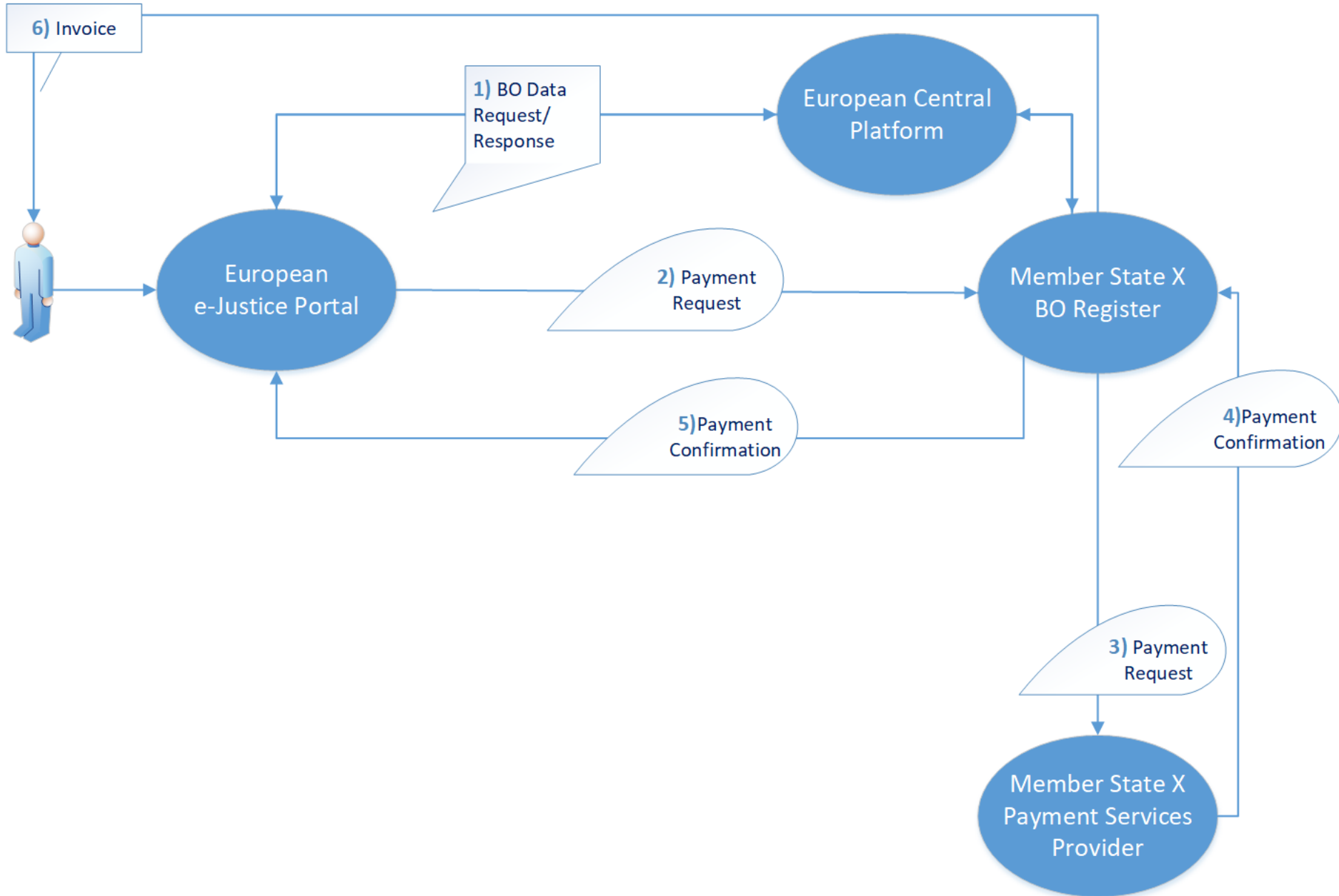
The **shopping basket** can contain documents from several Member States, but the checkout and payment will be done individually for each Member State.

Dedicated Member State web service for calculating the **VAT** of all documents in the shopping cart.

MS Land Registers send the **invoice** by email to the user at the address indicated in the invoicing information page.

Useful suggestion from Austria to reverse the order: LRI first retrieves the documents from the MS Land Register, and only then initiates the payment. This would avoid reimbursement complications in case the document delivery by the Land Register fails.

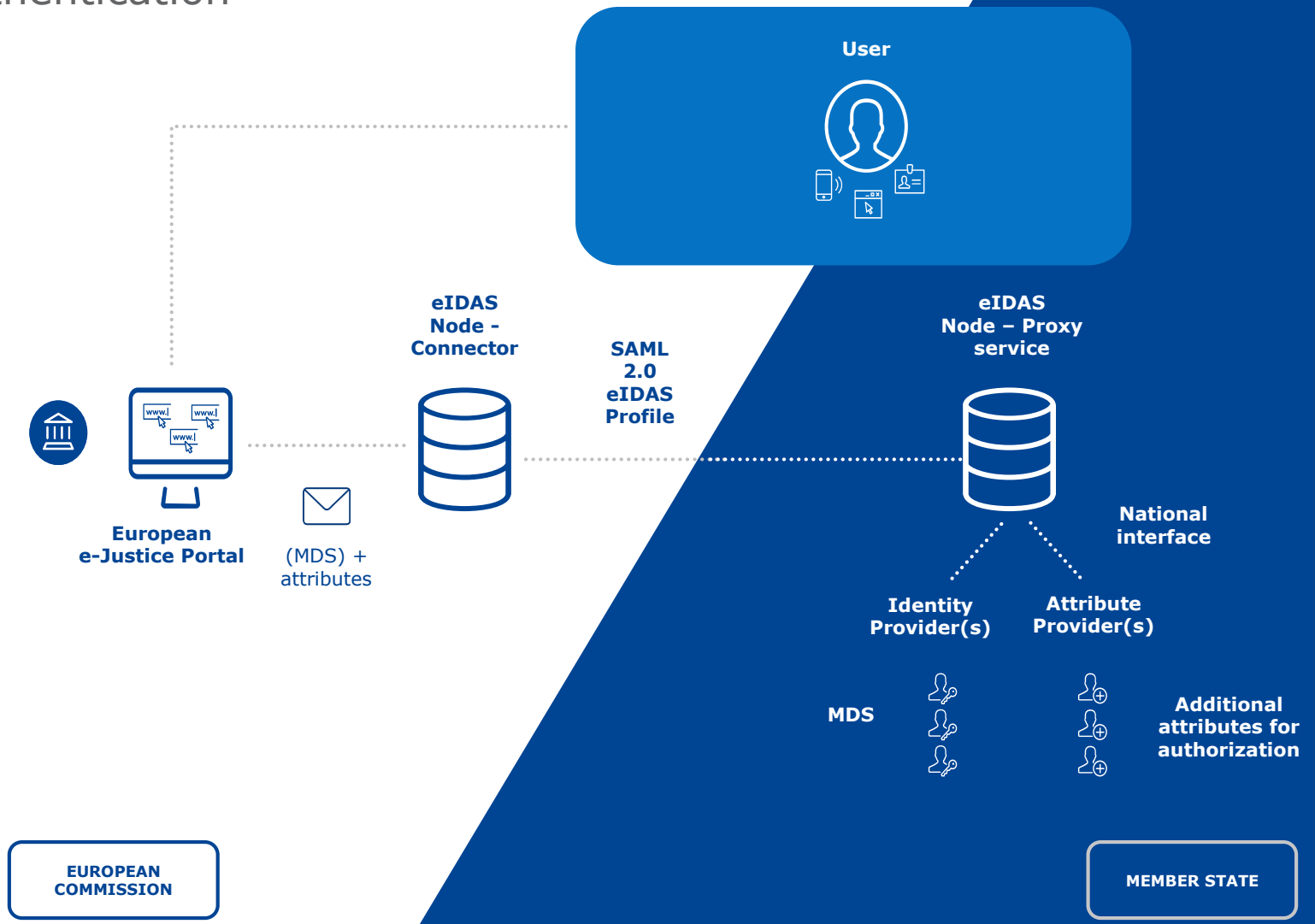
Authorization status and next steps

- 1) The eIDAS Technical Subgroup have approved in June 2021 the authorization proposal based on the additional eIDAS 'role' attribute.
- 2) The proposal was presented to the eIDAS policy Cooperation Network on 27 September in view of formal approval. Consultation ongoing until 8 October.
- 3) The results of the policy consultation will be presented at the next meeting of the eIDAS Technical Subgroup, and the next steps of the implementation will be discussed.
- 4) Commission: Add the attributes in the eIDAS XSD and EU Login, and implement the intermediate role selection page with sign-in/sign-out functionality.
- 5) MS Ministries of Interior: Add the attributes in the MS eIDAS nodes (an XML configuration file in the proxy) and implement a module for selecting the appropriate Attribute Provider based on the business domain.
- 6) Attribute Providers (Tax Authorities, Police, etc): Implement the authentication of a user based on the national registration number and the communication between the MS Identity Providers and Attribute Providers.

For Member States which do not have an official eIDAS node yet: The revised eIDAS Directive obliges MS to notify eID schemes.

The cross-sector meeting has shown differences in the roles of professional users within the justice domain, so we will continue in an independent way.

LRI search functionalities

Preparing the revamp of the LRI main search page as an address search using the Eurostat API, together with other improvements from the MS usability report.

Move the search by person/company name to the MS-specific search forms where allowed, instead of the EU-wide search form, and reserved it for authorized users where necessary.
